CARE AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:

QUARTZ

What is Quartz? Quartz is an engineered man made combining crushed quartz and resin. The materials are placed in molds to produce repeatable slabs. Each slab will look similar however colors could vary due to dye lots. The engineered stone is non-porous and doesn't require sealing. The crushed quartz is very dense and hard and will resist scratching. Due to the resin in the slabs quartz is not heat resistant and the use of trivets or hot pads is required.

Sealing Quartz: Quartz does not require sealer as it is non-porous.

Cleaning Quartz: In most cases a mild soap and water is all that is needed to clean quartz. Each manufacture as their own care and cleaning instructions for their product.
